

Ultimately, they pivoted from their brick-and-mortar business and started selling online, including in the Amazon store.

"We started focusing on what the future was going to be for the consumer," Oliver said. With Amazon, Ali+Oli sales outpaced the couple's expectations. "Our business has grown from zero to a lot," Alejandra said. "We do the same [in sales] as we did having three full retail stores open."
